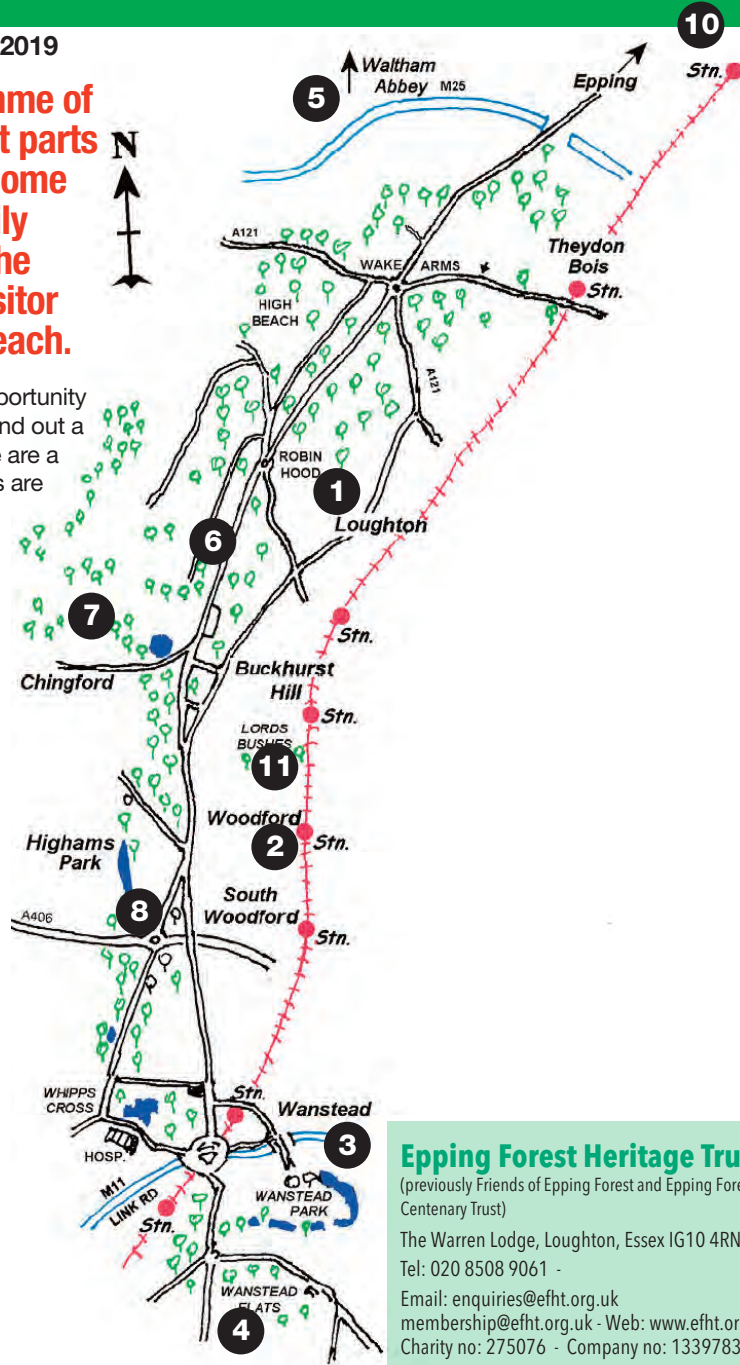


Epping Forest Heritage Trust Forest Walks and more
