

Public Transport

Rail Tube: Walthamstow Central

10 – 15 minutes walk from Walthamstow Central.

Buses from Walthamstow Central: 34/97/215/275/357 (three stops to the end of Hoe Street, where it meets Forest Road, Bell Corner).

Bus from Blackhorse Road or Tottenham Hale: 123

By Car

The entrance to the theatre is at the end of Winns Terrace, which is the road running parallel to the park.

Please note that Winns Terrace is a one-way road so please take the next one, which is Badliss Road.

When you reach the end turn right into Winns Terrace, drive straight ahead and enter the park between the railings. Continue around the building, and you'll find plenty of parking spaces in front of the theatre.
